Great Lakes Valley Conference

Established in 1978 with a commitment to the purposes, fundamental policies and basic principles of the National Collegiate Athletic Association, the Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC) has grown to embody the vision established by the founders of the organization and has melded athletic and academic excellence for 35 years.

The GLVC, which at one point over the past decade grew to 17 members and was the largest athletic conference in the country in any division, has fully embraced NCAA Division II. Although formed and developed as one of the nation's premier NCAA Division II basketball conferences, the GLVC now sponsors 20 championship sports, which includes the addition of football in 2012 and men's and women's swimming and diving in 2013-14.

The formation of the GLVC can be traced as far back as 1972 when the athletic directors of three schools - Kentucky Wesleyan College, Bellarmine

College (now Bellarmine University) and Indiana State University at Evansville (now the University of Southern Indiana) - began preliminary discussions about forming a basketball conference. Four years later, the University of Indianapolis and Saint Joseph's College expressed interest. On July 7, 1978, those schools - along with Ashland University - united to become the GLVC. Under the direction of 14-year Commissioner Jim Naumovich, the GLVC will be celebrating its 35th Anniversary with several online and social media campaigns over the course of the 2013-14 academic season, while a 30-second public service announcement has also been produced.

Since its inception, 16 different institutions have joined the league. Those members include: Lewis University (1980), Indiana-Purdue at Fort Wayne (1984), Northern Kentucky University (1985), Kentucky State University (1989), Quincy University (1994),

Southern Illinois University Edwardsville (1994), University of Wisconsin-Parkside (1994), University of Missouri-St. Louis (1995), Drury University (2005), Missouri University of Science & Technology (2005), Rockhurst University (2005), University of Illinois Springfield (2008), Maryville University (2008), William Jewell College (2009) and McKendree University (2010). Truman State University, which was admitted to the conference as a full-time member in July 2012, is competing in its first year as an active member during the 2013-14 season.

Ashland and Kentucky State left the conference after the 1994 season, IPFW left the league following the 2000-01 academic year, and SIU Edwardsville exited the league following the 2007-08 academic year. These departures opened the door for the seven-team expansion over the past decade, allowing the league to grow 17 institutions. Northern Kentucky departed following the 2011-12 season to bring the current membership to 16 schools. Truman then replaced charter member Kentucky Wesleyan, which left the league in 2013 to pursue membership in the Great Midwest Athletic Conference.

The conference sponsors 20 championships in baseball, basketball, cross country, football, golf, soccer, swimming and diving, indoor and outdoor track and field, and tennis for men, and basketball, cross country, softball, soccer, tennis, swimming and diving, indoor and outdoor track and field, golf, and volleyball for women.

In the history of the GLVC, member schools have

captured 12 NCAA Division II national championships, including nine on the men's side. Seven of those titles were earned in the sport of men's basketball, including Drury's national championship in 2013 and Bellarmine's title in 2011. Former member Kentucky Wesleyan won the 1987, 1990, 1999 and 2001 crowns under the GLVC umbrella, while Southern Indiana added a national title in 1995. Northern Kentucky won the school's first-ever women's basketball national championship in 2000 and followed that with a national title in 2008. In addition, Northern Kentucky became the first GLVC member to win a national championship in men's soccer, while USI staked claim to the GLVC's first baseball national championship in 2010. SIU Edwardsville was the first GLVC member to win a national championship in softball in 2007.

The league also takes pride in recognizing the many academic and athletic accomplishments achieved by its student-athletes, coaches and administrators. In 2012-13, the GLVC ranked third among 23 NCAA Division II conferences in Academic Success Rate (ASR) at 80 percent and third in the Federal Graduation Rate (FGR) at 62 percent for all student-athletes. In addition, a conference-record 2,002 student-athletes were recognized with Academic All-GLVC recognition in 2012-13, while a league-best 225 student-athletes earned the GLVC Council of Presidents' Academic Excellence Award for grade-point averages of 3.5 or higher.





Hawks Look To Reach Top Of GLVC

The Rockhurst Hawks enter the 2015 season with high expectations after a sub-par 2014 season. The Hawks will be returning a great deal of experience in the field after losing only two position players from the starting lineup. The Hawks also have returning inning and mound experience, having only lost two relievers and two starters from the 2014 rotation.

Entering his 22nd season with a 640-470 career record, head coach Gary Burns has high expectations for 2015. He looks to again top the ranks in the Great Lakes Valley Conference and push towards a run at the regional tournament.

Pitching

The Hawks' pitching staff will have some big shoes to fill with the graduation of professional ballplayer Josh Tols and Rockhurst Graduate Assistant Alex Seier. Additionally, senior RHP Thomas Woodard is out for the season due to a labrum tear. Com-

bined, the three former pitchers allotted for 441.2 innings pitched.

Rockhurst is happy to return both nine-inning starters from the 2014 season. Sophomore RHPs Joe Huber and Michael Lydon-Lorson will anchor the 2015 pitching staff. Both



players are coming off a successful season. They constantly went after and challenged hitters. Huber and Lydon-Lorson both have the ability to throw three pitches for strikes. They also are able to go deep into games, finishing with seven complete games together. Lydon-Lorson finished fifth in the conference with a 1.93 ERA.

After Huber and Lydon-Lorson, the Hawk rotation is somewhat unknown. Junior RHP Jake Goessling will likely be in the mix as he had an excellent season in the bullpen last year. He finished with a 2.35 ERA in 12 appearances for the Hawks. Goessling provides a mid-to-upper 80's fastball with a sharp-breaking slider and a solid change-up. He also held opposing hitters to a .195 batting average in the 2014 campaign. Goessling will bring veteran leadership to the pitching staff, as well as a "get-after-it" attitude.

Another pitcher that looks to bolster the rotation is senior RHP Zach Loeffelholz. He brings three years of experience pitching in the GLVC. Loeffelholz also brings the experience of pitching in the 2012 NCAA regional game against Grand Valley State University where he earned the 10-5 win. Loeffelholz battled multiple injuries but was able to finish with a 3-1 record in 13 appearances.

Newcomer Miles Kilgore, a Lee's Summit, Mo. native, will be a pitcher of interest to watch. He has a mid-toupper 80's fastball, and a solid breaking ball. Kilgore is a power pitcher that looks to over-match hitters and blow them away. He is a Lee's Summit North graduate who earned all-conference honors for three years and was also named to the Missouri High School All-Star Team. Kilgore will look to develop into a weekday starter for the Hawks.

Seniors Trenton Perry, Derec Olson and Thomas Cargile will look to anchor the Rockhurst bullpen. Collectively, they have appeared in 18 games and will serve as middle relief options for Coach Burns. Another pitcher to keep an eye on is redshirt junior Nathan Shores. Shores is coming off a medical redshirt where he tore both his labrum and his rotator cuff. He looks to have a big bounce back year.





Catcher

One of the most intensive position battles throughout the fall has been for the catcher position. The Hawks appear to be very deep, returning three guys who saw action in the 2014 season. Coach Burns looks for the catching unit to show improvement and provide more offensive production. He is excited for this group to produce.

After fall ball, redshirt senior Jake Jones appears to be the top option at the backstop. Jones broke into the starting lineup at the end of the 2014 season and took off. He finished the season with a batting average of .360, making 11 starts.

Redshirt junior Dalton Thompson, who served as the 2014 catcher until an injury sidelined him, also looks to split time. Thompson appeared in 26 games for the Hawks posting a .257 batting average. Junior Kyle Downey also saw action last year and will compete for playing time. He played in 14 games making six starts.

Infield

With the departure of the right side of the infield due to graduations, the Hawks will look towards a couple of older guys to take their places. At first base, Blake Petersen is expected to be

the man to take over the duties from Josh Dennett, who is now an assistant coach. Petersen filled the designated hitter/pinch hitter role in the 2014 season. He finished the year with the third highest batting average on the team at .343. Petersen provides the ability to drive the ball to both gaps.

Sophomore Corbin Hare who finished with a solid freshman campaign, is also expected to compete at first base. Hare collected six doubles last year and is coming off a very successful summer season.

Redshirt senior Matt Stacks, out in 2014 with a medical redshirt, looks to be in the mix at first base as well as one of the top options at designated hitter. Stacks is the only left-handed hitter returning and could also provide a veteran bat coming off the bench late in games. In the 2013 season, he collected nine RBI in 62 at bats.

Senior Patrick Burns makes the transition to second base, moving from the outfield. He looks to be the leader in that positional race. Burns greatly improved his defense on the infield earning him honors in his summer league. He finished the season with a .274 batting average for the Hawks.

Freshman newcomer Jeremy Lufft out of Blue Springs High School, had a very good fall and looks to compete



for the starting job at second base. He provides an option to play both middle infield positions. Lufft has very good speed and could also find his way into the lineup as a pinch runner.

At shortstop, sophomore Brett Marr returns after a solid freshman year. He is also coming off a very good summer season. He showed his commitment to the program by hitting the weight room to get bigger and stronger. Marr has the ability to be one of the best shortstops in the GLVC. Expectations are high, as he will be a middle of the order bat, and has the potential to drive in a lot of runs.

At the hot corner, sophomore Seth Soto looks to continue where he left off. He finished with a .305 batting average in 2014 and 11 RBI while battling an injury all year. Soto will also be a staple in the middle of the lineup.

Two players to keep an eye on throughout the season are junior Tim Mahoney and sophomore Skylar Smith. Both players can play all three infield positions and provide excellent defense. They both could find their way into the lineup as defensive replacements.

Outfield

The Rockhurst outfield looks to be one of the big strengths of the 2015 season. In left field, senior Caleb Baker will be the veteran presence as he enters his fourth year of service in the outfield. He possesses excellent arm strength and bat control. In 66 at bats during the 2014 season, Baker had a team-low five strikeouts. He also had a team-high seven sacrifice hits. Baker looks to be able to contribute at both the top and the bottom of the order and has the potential to drive the ball into the gaps. Additionally, coach has Baker slotted as a reliever in the back end of the bullpen.

Sophomore David Stober will man the center of the outfield. played center field during 2014 in 47 of the 48 games for the Hawks and



looks to continue that trend. Additionally, he will bolster the back end of the bullpen and is in the running for the closer position. Stober showed the most pop of the outfielders collecting 12 extra base hits, two of those being home runs. In addition to driving the ball in the gap, Stober looks to improve his contact.

Returning to right field is senior Calin McCourt. In the 2014 campaign, he earned all-conference honors and led the team with seven outfield assists. McCourt is an excellent team player; he came to the Rockhurst program as a walk-on and played on the junior varsity side for two years. He earned a roster spot in 2013 as a pinch runner and continued to improve, earing a role in the starting lineup at right field in 2014. He is one of the fastest guys on the team, which enabled him to obtain 10 stolen bases. Coach Burns looks to use McCourt's speed in all aspects of the game.

A couple of other guys to help out in the outfield will be sophomore Chase Leavy, sophomore Dylan Brauner and freshman Nick Pascuzzi. All players possess very good speed and will provide depth to an already strong outfield.

Schedule

The Rockhurst Hawks will begin their season, as they did last year, by making a road trip to Nashville, Tenn. While there, the Hawks will play both Tiffin and the Illinois Springfield on Belmont University's artificial turf baseball field, ES Rose Park.

In all, the Hawks' schedule will feature 25 home dates, including 18 home games against GLVC competition. Rockhurst will also face multiple MIAA opponents throughout the year. Washburn, Pittsburg State, Lincoln, Missouri Western and Central Missouri are all slated to face the Hawks. The one other DII non-conference matchup will be the Bemidji State Bea-

An addition to the schedule in the 2015 season will be St. Louis University. The Hawks will travel to St. Louis, where they will play a single 9-inning game against the Billikens (April 15) before they take on GLVC rival Missouri-St. Louis back in Kansas City (April 18-19).

GLVC action will open for Rockhurst when they travel to Westfield, Ind. to take on the Indianapolis Greyhounds (March 14-15). In the 2014 season, the Greyhounds finished 30-25 overall, with a 23-13 GLVC record.

The 2015 Great Lakes Valley Conference Baseball Championship will be held at Grand Park Complex in Westfield, Ind., just 30 minutes north of Indianapolis (May 7-10).

Now entering his 22nd season as the head coach of the Hawks, Coach Gary Burns takes a 640-470 career record into the 2015 baseball season.

Coach Burns has led the Hawks to 14 post-season appear-

ances, including six berths in the NCAA Division II Regional Tournament. The Hawks advanced to the finals of the 2012 NCAA Midwest Regional. In 1999, Rockhurst captured the NCAA Central Regional and finished fourth at the NCAA Division II Championships in Montgomery, Ala.

The Hawks went back to the NCAA regionals in 2000 and 2003, losing to Central Missouri State in the regional finals both times. In 2004, Burns was named the Coach of the Year in the Heartland Conference as he guided the Hawks to the conference tournament championship.





Rockhurst finished third in its first season in the Great Lakes Valley Conference in 2006 and earned a berth in the NCAA Great Lakes Regional. The Hawks finished second in the GLVC West and went to the NCAA Midwest Regional in 2009. Rockhurst's players have also succeeded in the classroom as the Hawks have graduated 91 percent of their players since 1994.

Burns had the honor of coaching 14 players that went on to play in the professional baseball. Prior to becoming the head coach at Rockhurst, Burns was an assistant coach at Indiana State (1982-85), Vanderbilt (1985-91) and Clemson (1991-92).

A 1981 graduate of Vanderbilt University, he posted a 9-3 record with four saves and was the ace reliever on Vandy's 1980 SEC championship team. He also played two seasons at Johnson County Community College. He had a 17-5 record with back-to-back ERAs of 1.16 and 1.92.

Coach Burns lives in Leawood, Kan., with his wife, Janet, and 16-year-old twin sons, Jim and Tack.

2014 Year in Review

The Rockhurst Hawks just missed qualifying for the GLVC conference tournament in Evansville, Ind. They finished 17-31 record overall and 15-20 record in GVLC play, finishing fifth in the west division. Poor weather and bad field conditions led to the Hawks to postpone and cancel nine games on the schedule.

For the first year, the Hawks didn't travel to Florida to play in the Clearwater Invitational. They changed things up beginning their season in Nashville playing against Trevecca Nazarene University. It begins the first year that the Hawks will travel down to Nashville and play non-conference competition.

The Hawks began the season on a slow note before getting into the win column, taking the series against McKendree University. They were also able to take series wins from Maryville University and Truman State University.

They went on to split series against Illinois Springfield University and William Jewell College, but lost series against University of Missouri-St. Louis, University of Missouri S&T, Drury University and Quincy University.

Rockhurst ranked fifth in the league in on-base percentage finishing at .363. The pitching staff also ranked in the top third in the conference with strikeouts per game. They struck out 4.92 batters per game.

2014 Senior first-baseman Josh Dennett finished fifth in the league in batting average at .378 and sixth in the league in on-base percentage at .464. Of the top ten guys in batting average, he was third with the least amount of strikeouts, 12.

The Hawks had two pitchers who finished in the top twenty in earned run average in the league. Michael Lydon-Lorson finished fifth with a 1.89 earned run average and Josh Tols finished twelfth with a 2.60 earned run average. Tols finished with 71 strikeouts which ranked fourth in the league.

Senior pitcher Josh Tols and junior outfielder Calin McCourt received GLVC recognition. They were both named to the All-GLVC West Second Team.

The Hawks were also able to succeed in the classroom with a 3.39 grade point average. Additionally, all 11 seniors received their diplomas and graduated.






